On May 11, 2017, I participated in the Credit Suisse Access Event: Conference Call with Missouri PSC Commissioner Scott T. Rupp hosted by Michael Weinstein, US Power & Utilities Research. The topic of the conference call was my thoughts on the current regulatory environment in Missouri, on-going efforts and initiatives to reform the regulatory structure in the state, and my views on the role of the regulated utilities in the state in delivering reliable and affordable services to customers in Missouri. However, during the call Mr. Weinstein asked me if I would expound on my recently filed dissent in case number ET-2016-0246. I informed Mr. Weinstein that the case was not final but that my public comments on the matter, which could be found on the Commission's electronic filing information system and my website Simplifying Energy.com dealt with the lack of a business case for the development of unregulated electric vehicle charging stations outside the major metropolitan areas of Missouri.
