**NOTICE OF COMPLETION OF TRANSACTIONS**

Comes Now MCI, Inc. ("MCI"), by its undersigned counsel, and on behalf of its subsidiary Missouri competitive telecommunications companies identified in the Application filed herein, pursuant to the Commission's November 13, 2003 Order Approving Corporate Restructuring, provides its Notice of Completion of Transactions.

1. On November 13, 2003 the Commission issued herein its Order Approving Corporate Restructuring regarding restructuring and related intra-corporate transactions to be undertaken to consummate the Plan of Reorganization under the WorldCom Chapter 11 Federal Bankruptcy proceeding.

2. As explained in the attached letters that were sent to the Commissioners, on April 20, 2004 MCI emerged from Chapter 11 bankruptcy protection and all corporate transactions that were part of the Plan of Reorganization took effect.

3. MCI and its subsidiaries provided advance notice to customers as required in the Commission's Order.

4. Revised tariffs will be submitted soon to complete the documentation of these changes. When these revised tariffs taking effect, the Commission will be able to cancel the certificates of authority issued to Brooks Fiber Communications of Missouri, Inc., Metropolitan Fiber Systems of St. Louis, Inc., and Metropolitan Fiber Systems of Kansas City, Inc. The Commission will also be able to cancel the local certificates of authority issued to MCI WorldCom Communications, Inc., but that subsidiary will retain its interexchange certificate of authority and continue IXC operations and services.

WHEREFORE, MCI requests the Commission to accept this Notice of Completion of Transactions.
