**KANSAS CITY POWER & LIGHT COMPANY'S
MOTION FOR EXPEDITED CONSIDERATION AND APPROVAL
OF TARIFF SHEET ON LESS THAN THIRTY DAYS' NOTICE**

COMES NOW Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L" or the "Company") and hereby files its Motion for Expedited Consideration and Approval of Tariff Sheet on Less than Thirty Days' Notice ("Motion"). In support of its Motion, KCP&L states as follows:

1. KCP&L filed tariff sheets on June 1, 2016 with an effective date of August 1, 2016 to adjust its Demand Side Investment Mechanism ("DSIM") Rider.
2. On July 20, 2016, the Commission issued an order rejecting the tariff sheets and authorizing KCP&L to file new tariff sheet 490.
3. Contemporaneous with this Motion, KCP&L filed compliance tariff sheet 490 with a 30 day effective date.
4. KCP&L requests that the Commission approve the tariff sheet to become effective on August 1, 2016 so that the Company can comply with Commission rules that require semi-annual adjustments of its DSIM rates.
5. This Motion was filed as soon as it could have been under the circumstances.

WHEREFORE, KCP&L respectfully requests that the Commission grant KCP&L's Motion and approve tariff sheet 490 to go into effect on less than thirty days' notice.
