APPLICATION AND MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT

COMES NOW Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCPL") pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.060 and 4 CSR 240-2.080(16) for its Application and Motion for Expedited Treatment to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") states:

KCPL

- 1. KCPL is a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Missouri, with its principal office at 1201 Walnut, Kansas City, Missouri 64106-2124. KCPL's Certificate of Good Standing was provided in Case No. EF-2002-315 and is incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. KCPL holds Certificates of Convenience and Necessity from the Commission to transact business as an electric public utility in certain areas of the State of Missouri and is principally engaged in the generation, transmission, distribution and sale of electric power and energy.

4. KCPL has heretofore filed with this Commission a certified copy of the Articles of Consolidation under which it was organized and of all amendments thereto.

5. KCPL has no pending action or final unsatisfied judgments or decisions against it from any state or federal agency or court, which involve customer service or rates, which has occurred within three (3) years of the date of this Application, except as identified on Exhibit 1 hereto. No annual report or assessment fees are overdue.

Amend Nuclear Decommissioning Trust Agreement

6. KCPL requests approval to amend its nuclear decommissioning trust agreement ("Agreement") as required by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("NRC") in a rule recently promulgated, as published in the Federal Register (Vol. 67 FR, p. 78332). The revisions to 10 CFR 50.75(h)(2) will become effective December 24, 2003. The change to the Agreement to make it consistent with the revised rule would provide:

Except for withdrawals being made under 10 CFR 50.82(a)(8), no disbursement or payment may be made from the trust until written notice of the intention to make a disbursement or payment has been given the Director, Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation, at least 30 working days before the date of the intended disbursement or payment.

Motion for Expedited Treatment

- 7. Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.080(16), KCPL is requesting expedited treatment of this application.
- 8. KCPL requests approval of the application by November 24, 2003, to accommodate making this change to the Agreement.
- 9. KCPL was recently notified that in order for the Agreement to remain in compliance with the NRC's rule this change in the Agreement is necessary.

WHEREFORE, KCPL requests that the Commission issue an Order approving a change in the nuclear decommissioning trust agreement to conform with the NRC rules and affording KCPL expedited treatment of this application.
