NOTICE OF INTENDED CASE FILING

COMES NOW Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L"), by and through counsel, and files this Notice of Intended Case Filing. In this regard, KCP&L respectfully states to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("the Commission"):

1. KCP&L is a Missouri corporation with its principal office and place of business at 1200 Main Street, Kansas City, Missouri 64105. KCP&L is primarily engaged in the business of generating, transmitting, distributing, and selling electric energy in portions of eastern Kansas and western Missouri. KCP&L is an electric corporation and public utility as defined in Section 386.020, Mo. Rev. Stat. (2000), as amended.¹ KCP&L provided its Certificate of Good Standing in Case No. EF-2002-315 which is incorporated herein by reference.

2. Commission Rule 4-CSR 240-4.020 provides, in pertinent part, as follows:

(2) Any regulated entity that intends to file a case likely to be a contested case shall file a notice with the secretary of the commission a minimum of sixty (60) days prior to filing such case. Such notice shall detail the type of case and issues likely to be before the commission.

3. It is KCP&L's intent to file an application pursuant to Section 393.190 for (1) approval of the transfer of existing common facilities located at the Iatan Generating Station to the Kansas Electric Power Cooperative, Inc. ("KEPCo") and the Missouri Joint Municipal Electric Utility Commission ("MJMEUC"); (2) approval of the transfer of interests in permits to other owners of the new Iatan Unit 2 electric generating facility ("Unit 2"); (3) approval to enter

into the Unit 2 Site lease; and (4) approval, if deemed necessary, for the sale of an interest in utility property to KEPCo and MJMEUC.

WHEREFORE, KCP&L submits to the Commission and its Secretary this Notice of Intended Case Filing.
