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**RESPONSE OF KANSAS CITY POWER & LIGHT COMPANY AND KCP&L
GREATER MISSOURI OPERATIONS COMPANY
TO ORDER DIRECTING FILING**

COMES NOW Kansas City Power & Light Company (“KCP&L”) and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (“GMO”)(collectively referred to as “Applicants”), hereby responds to the Commission’s Order Suspending Tariffs And Directing Filings, And Notice Of Contested Case which was issued on January 6, 2010. For its Response, the Applicants state as follows:

1. On December 29, 2009, the Applicants filed an Application For Accounting Authority seeking an order authorizing Applicants: (i) to record all incremental operating expenses associated with the Renewable Energy Standard in USOA Account 182; (2) to annually calculate AFUDC on the balances in those regulatory assets; and (iii) to amortize those costs for financial reporting purposes over a ten (10) year period to the appropriate USOA Account commencing with the effective date of new rates in KCP&L’s next general rate case. In addition, Applicants filed tariffs which would implement their Solar Rebate Programs.

2. On January 6, 2010, the Commission issued its Order Suspending Tariffs And Directing Filings, And Notice of Contested case which, among other things,

directed that the Applicants file a response by January 8, 2010, to address whether the Commission should decide the application and tariffs on an expedited basis.

3. The Applicants did not request that the Commission decide this matter on an expedited basis in their Application and cover letters accompanying their tariffs. Of course, the Applicants would like the Commission to resolve the matter as soon as is practicable and convenient for the Commission. However, the Applicants do not believe this matter needs to be expedited. From the perspective of the Applicants, the proposed Solar Rebate Program tariffs may be processed independently from their Application For Accounting Authority Order.
