comes now International Telecharge, Inc., by and through its
attorneys, and states:

1. Accompanying this pleading is International Telecharge, Inc.'s ("ITI") Mo. P.S.C. Tariff Sheets 1 through 40 presented to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") for filing on this 30th day of May, 1989.

2. These Tariff Sheets carry an effective date which has been left blank, pending the outcome of this Motion.

3. ITI is certified to do business in the State of Missouri as a telecommunication company pursuant to Section 386.020(39), RSMo. (1986), and the rates charged for the services rendered have already been approved by the Commission in respect to AT&T.

4. In addition, the services outlined in the tariff have previously been provided to Missouri customers by other telecommunication companies, pursuant to Section 392.220(4), RSMo. (1986).

5. Furthermore, these tariffs are in compliance with the conditions contained in the Commission's Report and Order in Case Number TA-88-218, which deals with the issues of billing for incomplete or emergency calls, identification of the provider, rate quotes, verification of calling cards, splashing, and

emergency call procedures.

6. Lastly, this filing is submitted in order to comply with the Order Granting Partial Stay issued May 30, 1989, by the Circuit Court of Cole County, Missouri, in Case Number CV189-506CC, in which it was agreed that ITI, as a condition of the Stay Order, is to charge rates identical to AT&T and to follow the above set out conditions of the Report and Order in Case Number TA-88-218. Since, as a condition of the Circuit Court's Order, the attached tariffs must be followed by ITI, a shortened time for effective date is proper.

WHEREFORE, ITI respectfully requests that the standard thirty (30) day effective date requirement be waived and that, for good cause shown, the tariffs in this matter be put into effect immediately or as soon as practically possible.
