- 5. In order to be able to cause said notices to be in the hands of customers one week in advance of the hearings, a Commission decision on this matter by Monday, October 3, 2005, is necessary.

WHEREFORE, in the event the Commission determines to hold local public hearings in this matter, Aquila, on behalf of the participating parties, moves that the Commission issue its Order approving the form of the notices as provided herewith and indicate the date, time and location of each hearing.
