MOTION TO CHANGE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Comes now Missouri Gas Energy ("MGE"), a division of Southern Union Company, and for its motion to change the procedural schedule respectfully states:

1. Direct testimony in this proceeding is currently due on November 9, 2005, pursuant to the Commission's Order Adopting Procedural Schedule issued September 13, 2005. Several situations, including a serious medical condition, have adversely affected the ability of MGE to meet that deadline. MGE has communicated this to the other parties. After discussion, the parties have agreed on a new schedule that essentially moves the existing milestones approximately two weeks. The dates scheduled for the hearing move approximately three weeks to accommodate the Commission's scheduling calendar. This is only a change in the dates set in the September 13 Order. As the Commission is aware, the issues involving Kansas Pipeline have been bifurcated out and are being held in abeyance pending the outcome of the appeal of GR-96-450, pursuant to previous Commission order, and therefore are not to be addressed or considered pursuant to the schedule being proposed here.

2. The parties have agreed to propose the following new schedule:

Direct testimony by all parties wishing to file: November 23, 2005

Rebuttal testimony by all parties wishing to file: February 1, 2006

Surrebuttal testimony by all parties wishing to file: March 16, 2006

List of issues, witnesses, order of cross:

March 23, 2006

Prehearing briefs

March 28, 2006

Hearing

April 10, 11, 12 and 13, 2006

The parties recommend that the proceedings commence at 8:30 a.m. on Monday, April 10, 2006.

WHEREFORE, MGE on behalf of the parties respectfully requests that the Commission establish the new procedural schedule shown above.
