MOTION TO CLARIFY ORDER APPROVING STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, by and through counsel, and for its *Motion to Clarify Order Approving Stipulation and Agreement* in this matter hereby respectfully states:

1. On April 11, 2014, Laclede Gas Company d/b/a Missouri Gas Energy (MGE) and other parties filed a Stipulation and Agreement resolving all issues in this matter.

2. April 23, 2014, the Commission issued its Order Approving Stipulation and Agreement ("Order").

3. Staff hereby requests the Commission issue an order clarifying its Order Approving Stipulation and Agreement in the following respects:

4. First, the first sentence of the Order states that "On September 16, 2013, Missouri Gas Energy (MGE) filed a request, with a revised tariff, to increase its rates by \$17 million." Staff requests that this sentence be clarified by adding the phrase: "exclusive of amounts that were then being collected by the Company through its Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge (ISRS)."¹

5. Next, page 2 of the Order noted that the Stipulation and Agreement "provides for a decrease in residential fixed rates from \$28.10 to \$27.87 until October 1, 2014. Thereafter, residential fixed rates will be further reduced to \$23.00." Staff

requests that this sentence be clarified by adding the phrase: "and a year-round residential delivery charge of \$0.0738 per hundred cubic feet (Ccf) will be added."²

Also on Page 2, the Order states: "The fixed monthly charge for Small 6. General Service Customers will be reduced from \$41.04 to \$40.74 until October 1, 2014, then reduced to \$34.00." Staff requests this sentence be clarified with this additional sentence: "Also after October 1, 2014, rates for Small General Service will include a year-round delivery charge of \$0.0543 per Ccf."³

7. These clarifications do not change or otherwise affect the substance of the Stipulation and Agreement, the Commission's Order, or the compliance tariffs filed in this matter; rather, they provide additional clarity for the general public and the media about the Company's initial request and the resolution of the case as provided by the Agreement and the Commission's Order.

8. Staff has discussed this motion will all parties to this case, and all parties have stated they do not object to these clarifications.

WHEREFORE, Staff requests the Commission issue an order clarifying its Order Approving Stipulation and Agreement as described above.
