**CENTURYTEL OF MISSOURI, LLC AND SPECTRA COMMUNICATIONS  
GROUP, LLC D/B/A CENTURYTEL'S MOTION TO EXTEND  
FILING OF PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

COME NOW CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC ("CenturyTel") and Spectra Communications Group, LLC d/b/a CenturyTel ("Spectra") (collectively referred to herein as "Movants"), pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.050(3)(A), and in support of their Motion to Extend Filing of Proposed Procedural Schedule respectfully state as follows:

1. At the Conference held in this matter on October 11, 2005, the presiding officer ordered the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule by October 18, 2005. This order was memorialized in the Notice Regarding Filing of Proposed Procedural Schedule issued herein on October 12, 2005.

2. Movants respectfully advise the Commission that, pursuant to discussions initiated during the above-referenced Conference, the parties currently are engaged in settlement negotiations that may resolve the issues raised in this matter. Movants anticipate that such negotiations should be concluded within a two-week period, such that this matter can be resolved by the withdrawal of the subject tariffs and the re-filing of tariffs containing agreed upon language, or the parties will file a proposed procedural schedule at that time.

3. Accordingly, Movants respectfully request that the date for the filing of a proposed procedural schedule be extended for two weeks, to November 1, 2005.

4. Movants are authorized to state that none of the parties to this proceeding object to the relief requested herein.

WHEREFORE, CenturyTel and Spectra respectfully request that the Commission extend the date for the filing of a proposed procedural schedule in this matter for two weeks, to November 1, 2005.
