KANSAS CITY POWER & LIGHT COMPANY'S RESPONSE TO AGENDA DISCUSSION OF AUGUST 12, 2015

COMES NOW Kansas City Power & Light Company and hereby submits to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") its Response to Agenda Discussion of August 12, 2015.

- 1. On August 12, 2015, the Commission discussed this case during its duly noticed public agenda session at its Jefferson City offices. During the discussion, a Commissioner made a number of broad comments expressing a negative impression of KCP&L's management ability, customer service quality, and overall corporate culture. These comments are not reflective of KCP&L's culture or its hard working employees. Therefore, KCP&L respectfully disagrees and files this pleading in response to those comments.
- 2. During the course of five public hearings, less than 20 of KCP&L's approximately 270,000 Missouri customers raised service-related issues, but in KCP&L's experience, neither the number nor character of the issues were abnormal for this kind of proceeding. Moreover the record shows that KCP&L promptly took steps to address these issues. See Ex. 121, Ives Surrebuttal at 64-67. There is no fair or reasonable basis to infer from these isolated instances that KCP&L's management ability, customer service quality or corporate culture are sub-par. In fact, the record evidence demonstrates KCP&L's longstanding commitment to efficient and effective operations, high quality customer service and a corporate culture striving for enterprise-wide continuous improvement. See Ex. 114, Heidtbrink Direct at

4-14; Ex. 120, Ives Rebuttal at 3-7; Ex. 149; Ex. 168; and Tr. 1299-1305, 1311-13-18.

WHEREFORE, KCP&L respectfully submits this Response to Agenda Discussion on August 12, 2015.
