Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L" or the "Company") submits its response to the Staff ("Staff") of the Missouri Public Service Commission's ("Commission") Report of MEEIA Prudence Review ("Staff Audit"), filed in this docket on November 1, 2018, as follows:

I. <u>KCP&L RESPONSE</u>

1. The Company does not agree with Staff's proposed ordered adjustments of approximately \$48,000 in MEEIA costs as these costs were prudently incurred marketing and promotional expenses necessary to promote and encourage participation in the Company's MEEIA programs. The Company requests a hearing before the Commission to preserve its right to contest Staff's proposed ordered adjustment.

2. In addition, regarding Staff's proposed disallowance of promotional items listed in Table 7 of Staff's Report, one invoice (Invoice 2DP2087793; Amount \$5,622.75) listed in the table had already been removed by the Company from MEEIA program costs by voucher correction. The Company plans on discussing this item along with the prudence of the other expenditures listed in Staff's Report before any hearing is scheduled. **WHEREFORE**, Kansas City Power & Light Company respectfully requests the Commission consider this response to the Staff Audit.
