NOTICE CONCERNING CONDITIONS

COMES NOW Confluence Rivers Utility Operating Company, Inc., (“Confluence Rivers” or “Company”) and for its *Notice Concerning Conditions* respectfully states as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”):

1. On December 8, 2022, the Commission issued its *Order Approving Acquisition of Assets and Granting Certificates of Convenience and Necessity* (“Order”) in this case. The *Order*, among other things, requires Confluence Rivers to “. . . file notice in this case outlining completion of the above-recommended training, customer communications, notification and billing within ten days after such communications and notifications are completed.” (*Order*, p. 11, para. 3 (m)).

2. In compliance with the Commission’s *Order*, Confluence Rivers hereby provides notice to the Commission that that it has completed the items in paragraph 3 referenced by the above requirement, as to all systems acquired.
