ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE OF PETITION FOR ARBITRATION AND SCHEDULING INITIAL ARBITRATION MEETING

On December 5, 2008, Sprint Communications Company L.P., Sprint Spectrum L.P., and Nextel West Corp. (collectively referred to as "Sprint") filed a verified petition for arbitration with the Missouri Public Service Commission pursuant to Section 252(b) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, requesting that the Commission arbitrate unresolved issues for an interconnection agreement between Sprint and Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri. The Commission appointed Deputy Chief Regulatory Law Judge Nancy Dippell as Arbitrator on December 11, 2008.

Since AT&T is a party to the agreement, the Commission finds that AT&T is necessary and indispensable to a resolution of this matter and shall be made a party. The Commission will direct the Data Center to provide notice of this petition to AT&T. AT&T shall be permitted to file a response to the petition with any additional information they choose to provide.

Initial Arbitration Meeting

The federal Telecommunications Act requires that this arbitration be completed by April 1, 2009. Due to the short amount of time available for this arbitration, the arbitrator will

promptly schedule an initial arbitration meeting. At this meeting, the parties will be expected to consider and propose a procedural schedule that will allow this arbitration to proceed in the time allowed by statute. If any of the parties desire to appear at the initial meeting by telephone, they shall notify the Arbitrator as directed below.

THE ARBITRATOR ORDERS THAT:

- The Data Center shall serve notice of this petition upon Southwestern Bell
 Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri.
- 2. Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri, is made a party to this case.
