**NOTICE OF CORRECTED TESTIMONY PAGE**

COMES NOW The Empire District Electric Company, a Liberty Utilities company ("Liberty-Empire" or the "Company") and submits this Notice of Corrected Testimony Page in the above captioned Fuel and Purchased Power Adjustment docket. In this regard, Liberty-Empire respectfully states as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission"):

1. On April 1, 2019, Liberty-Empire filed the Direct Testimony of Leslie L. Forest in support of the Company's Fuel & Purchased Power Adjustment Clause rate schedules to reflect the actual energy costs that Empire incurred during the six-month period September 2018 through February 2019.

2. As a result of the Staff Auditor's review of the Company's testimony, the Company is submitting a corrected page 6 of Ms. Forest's testimony to correct the following inadvertent errors: (a) a reference to September 2019 on page 6, line 13 should have been to September 2018; (b) on page 6, line 17, the words "to return" were changed "to charge" to reflect that the Company had experienced an under-collection as otherwise described in Ms.

Forest's testimony, and; (c) on page 6, line 18, the word "decrease" was changed to the word "increase."


3. In addition, the Company would note that its cover letter in support of the true-up adjustments of eligible fuel and purchased power costs during the Recovery Period ending November 30, 2018 referred to an over collection which should have stated that the Company in fact had an under-collection of such fuel and purchased power costs.

WHEREFORE, Liberty-Empire submits this Notice and requests such relief as is just and proper under the circumstances.
