### APPLICATION OF KANSAS CITY POWER & LIGHT COMPANY FOR LEAVE TO INTERVENE

Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.075 and the Order and Notice issued by the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") on June 28, 2006 in the above-captioned proceeding, Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCPL") hereby applies to intervene and to become a party to the above-captioned case. In support thereof, KCPL states as follows:

1. KCPL is a Missouri corporation, in good standing in all respects, with its principal office and place of business located at 1201 Walnut, Kansas City, Missouri 64106. KCPL is engaged in the generation, transmission, distribution, and sale of electric energy and power in those areas in Missouri certificated to it by the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission"), including the City of Kansas City, Missouri, as well as in areas of eastern Kansas.

2. KCPL is an "electrical corporation" and "public utility" as those terms are defined in Mo. Rev. Stat. § 386.020 (2000), and as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission as provided by law. KCPL provides electric service to approximately 230,000 residential customers and approximately 30,100 commercial and industrial customers in Missouri. KCPL's Certificate of Good Standing was filed with the Commission in Case No. EM-2000-464 and is incorporated herein by reference.

3. KCPL has pending or final judgments or decisions against it from state or federal regulatory agencies or courts which involve customer service occurring with in the three (3) years immediately preceding the filing of this application, except as listed in Exhibit A. KCPL has a general rate case pending before the Commission in Case No. ER-2006-0314. KCPL has no overdue Commission annual reports or assessment fees.

5. On June 23, 2006, Aquila, Inc. ("Aquila") submitted an application to the Commission in the above-captioned proceeding seeking a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing Aquila to construct and operate an electrical distribution substation and related facilities to be located within Jackson County, within incorporated Kansas City and near the City of Raymore, Missouri (the "Raymore North Substation"). The Commission issued an Order and Notice on February June 28, 2006, wherein, among other things, the Commission ordered that any interested party seeking to intervene due so by July 13, 2006.

6. In the June 28, 2006 Order and Notice the Commission questioned, "whether Aquila needs to presently seek Commission authority to construct the proposed substation." As an electric utility with transmission and distribution assets located in Missouri, KCPL will likely

be impacted by the Commission's resolution of this issue. Consequently, KCPL's interest in this proceeding is different from that of the general public and cannot be represented by any other party to these proceedings. Actions taken by the Commission in this proceeding may substantially affect KCPL's legal and financial interests.

7. KCPL believes that it is unnecessary for Aquila to seek the relief it requests in this proceeding.

**WHEREFORE**, KCPL respectfully requests that the Commission issue an order authorizing it to intervene in the above-captioned matter.
