Good day. It is my understanding that your complaint before the Missouri Public Service Commission (EC-2000-750) will be withdrawn for these considerations:

- A) An apology from Kansas City Power & Light Company;
- Promise to remove the \$10 Reconnect Fee; and B)
- KCPL's promise to insist on positive identification for anyone calling in C) claiming to be Florence Butler.

On behalf of KCPL, I extend this apology for the unfortunate fact that your case has gone to such extreme to find resolution. I do appreciate your taking the time to allow the Missouri Public Service Commission's Anne Ross to speak with you and facilitate a closure to this complaint. Again, please accept my apology.

With respect to item B), the reconnection charge will be removed from your account.
