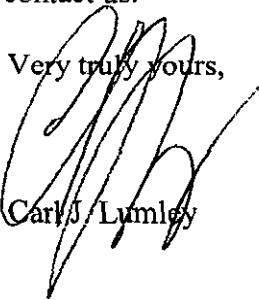

Come now MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC (MCImetro), Brooks Fiber Communications of Missouri, Inc., (Brooks) and MCI WorldCom Communications, Inc. (MCIWC) (collectively "Intervenors") pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.075 and Commission Order in this case and for their Application to Intervene state to the Commission:

1. MCImetro is a Delaware limited liability company in good standing duly authorized to conduct business in Missouri with regulatory offices at 701 Brazos, Suite 600, Austin, Texas 78701. MCImetro is authorized as a competitive local exchange carrier under certificate granted and tariffs approved by the Commission.

2. Brooks is a Delaware corporation in good standing duly authorized to conduct business in Missouri with regulatory offices at 701 Brazos, Suite 600, Austin, Texas 78701. Brooks is authorized as a competitive local exchange carrier under certificate granted and tariffs approved by the Commission.

3. MCIWC is a Delaware corporation in good standing duly authorized to conduct business in Missouri with regulatory offices at 701 Brazos, Suite 600, Austin, Texas 78701. MCIWC is authorized as a competitive local exchange carrier under certificate granted and tariffs approved by the Commission.

4. All communications and pleadings in this case should be directed to:

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5. On or about March 29, 2002, Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P. d/b/a Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) filed a tariff sheet that would extend certain expiring winback promotions, which tariff had an effective date of April 9, 2002. On April 5, 2002, the Commission issued an order suspending the tariff until May 9, 2002 in order to allow the Commission to further study the tariff. On April 18, 2002, the Commission issued its order further suspending tariff and directing notice and establishing an intervention deadline of May 9, 2002.

6. Intervenors seek to intervene in this proceeding because the Commission's decision will affect their interests as providers of telecommunications services in competition against SWBT.

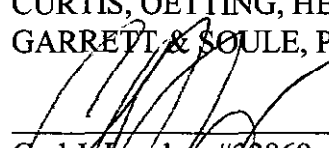
7. Intervenor's interests as telecommunications companies are different from those of the general public. Furthermore, their intervention in this proceeding is in the public interest because

of their interest in enhancing competition and because of their expertise in the telecommunications industry.

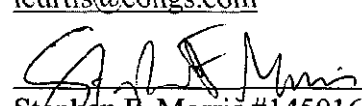
8. Intervenors oppose SWBT's proposed tariff, which includes unlawfully discriminatory winback discounts that would adversely impair competition contrary to the public interest.

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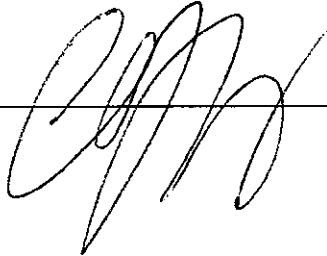
