## THE SMALL TELEPHONE COMPANY GROUP'S AND FIDELITY'S APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE

Come now the Small Telephone Company Group, members of which are set out in Attachment A, Fidelity Telephone Company and Bourbeuse Telephone Company (hereinafter "Fidelity") (both the Small Telephone Company Group and Fidelity are sometimes collectively referred to as "Applicants") and in support of their Application to Participate Without Intervention in the above-captioned matter state that:

1. Applicants currently provide telecommunication services to members of the public located in those areas certificated to them by the Missouri Public Service Commission

("Commission"). As is relevant to this case, Applicants provide "local telecommunication services" within the exchanges as defined by their respective tariffs which are on file with and approved by the Commission. Applicants are "telecommunications companies" and "public utilities" as those terms are defined by Section 386.020, RSMO 1994, and are, therefore subject to the jurisdiction, regulation and control of the Commission as provided by law. Applicants also are rural telephone companies and incumbent local exchange carrie. s as defined by the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the "Act").

3. On July 29, 1997, GTE Midwest Incorporated ("GTE") and Dial Call, Inc. (Nextel Communications or "Nextel") filed an Application with the Commission for approval of an interconnection agreement. The Application was filed for approval under the provisions of the Act, and the parties state that the agreement complies with § 252(e) of the Act, is not discriminatory and is consistent with the public interest.

4. On July 31, 1997, the Commission issued its Order and Notice in the instant docket. This order, among other things, established a deadline for the filing of applications to participate without intervention and a date for filing comments.

5. Applicants have obtained a copy of the interconnection agreement but, as of the filing of this application, have not had time to thoroughly review its contents and provisions. Nevertheless, Applicants file this Application because of their concerns that the interconnection agreement may have an impact on their operations and/or their existing relationships with GTE and Nextel. More specifically Applicants are concerned with the effect, if any, the proposed interconnection agreement with a wireless carrier may have upon agreements between wireless carriers and other local exchange companies in light of the Commission's recent ruling in <u>United Telephone Company of Missouri's Complaint Against Southwestern Bell Telephone Company for Failure to Pay Terminating Access for Cellular-Originated Calls Terminating in United's Territory, Case No. TC-96-112, and</u>

Southwestern Bell Telephone Company's recent tariff filing designed to revise its Wireless Carrier Interconnection Service, Case No. TT-97-524. Applicants, therefore, have an interest in this proceeding which is different from that of the general public. Applicants' expertise in and perspective on the provision of telecommunications services in the state will also aid the Commission in determining whether or not the proposed interconnection agreement 1) discriminates against another telecommunication carrier or 2) is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity. Consequently, Applicants participation in this docket will serve the public interest.

WHEREFORE, the Small Telephone Company Group and Fidelity respectfully request that the Commission issue an Order authorizing them to participate without intervention in the above captioned proceeding and for such other orders as are reasonable in the circumstances.
