**MOTION TO OPEN CASE AND CANCEL CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE
AUTHORITY AND ACCOMPANYING TARIFF**

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff), and moves that the Commission open a case and cancel the certificate of service authority it has granted to Network Communications International Corp., solely with respect to its use of the fictitious name of Mundo Telecom to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in Missouri, as well as its tariff. In support of its Motion, Staff respectfully states as follows:

1. On August 13, 2004, the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) issued an order granting a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services to Network Communications International Corp. under the fictitious name Mundo Telecom in Case No. XA-2004-0622, and approved its tariff, P.S.C. Mo. Tariff No. 1, in the same case.

2. Network Communications International Corp. d/b/a Mundo Telecom, through a letter from its agent, has asked the Commission to cancel its certificate of service authority because it has no customers using the service that was to be provided under that name, and does not intend to pursue that line of business. See Appendix A. The agent is the same representative who prepared and filed the company's 2005 annual report, and the president of Network Communications International Corp. verified that report.

3. Network Communications International Corp. d/b/a Mundo Telecom owes no annual reports or assessments. No complaints have been submitted with respect to the company since the commencement of the Electronic Filing and Information System.

4. Network Communications International Corp. holds certificates of service authority to do business in its own name and also under the name of 1800Call4Less. These certificates are *not* affected by this filing, and should remain active.

5. Because Network Communications International Corp. has requested cancellation of its certificate to do business under the name Mundo Telecom, and because it is not providing telecommunications service in Missouri under that name, the Staff recommends that the Commission issue an order canceling Network Communications International Corp. d/b/a Mundo Telecom's certificate of service authority, as well as its tariff.

6. The Commission has the authority to cancel a telecommunications corporation certificate pursuant to Section 392.410.5 RSMo (Supp. 2006), which provides:

"Any certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected."

However, the Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing. *State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission*, 776 S.W.2d 494 (Mo.App. 1989).

7. This pleading is being served on the address provided by the company to the Commission via certified mail, as well as upon its Missouri registered agent and the address provided to the Commission by Network Communications International Corp. d/b/a Mundo Telecom's consultant.

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends the Commission cancel the certificate of service authority of Network Communications International Corp. d/b/a Mundo Telecom to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services; and also its tariff, P.S.C. Mo. Tariff No. 1.


