VERIZON MIDWEST'S ANSWER AND MOTION TO DISMISS

On October 26, 2001 Mr. Wood filed a formal complaint with the Public Service Commission of Missouri ("Commission") alleging that he was not responsible for certain charges that appeared on his account that closed in May 1999. The total charges in dispute equal \$143.72.

Verizon Midwest states as follows:

- 1. Verizon Midwest admits that it provided ISDN service to Mr. Wood.
- Verizon Midwest explained to Mr. Wood the nature of the charges in two informal proceedings, one in 1999 and one in 2001.
- Verizon Midwest Received Partial payments from Mr. Wood, and credited these payments to Mr. Wood's regulated services.
- 4. The remaining balance owed by Mr. Wood (\$143.72) is for internet access service provided by Verizon Online. Verizon Online is a non-regulated internet service provider and the service that it provides is non-regulated service.

- 5. Verizon Midwest denies all other allegations in Mr. Wood's complaint.
- 6. Given that the amount in dispute relates to a non-regulated service provided by a non-regulated entity, Verizon Midwest respectfully requests that the Commission dismiss the complaint.
