LACLEDE’S NOTICE OF INTENDED CASE FILING

COMES NOW Laclede Gas Company (“Laclede”) and, pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-4.020, files this Notice of Intended Case Filing (this “Notice”), respectfully stating as follows:

1. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-4.020(2) provides, in part, as follows:

Any regulated entity that intends to file a case likely to be a contested case shall file a notice with the secretary of the commission a minimum of sixty (60) days prior to filing such case. Such notice shall detail the type of case and issues likely to be before the commission.

2. Laclede currently intends to file a general rate case prior to the end of calendar 2012. Laclede last filed a rate case in December 2009, so it will be approximately three years between rate cases. Laclede expects that the rate case is likely to involve a host of financial and tariff issues.

WHEREFORE, Laclede respectfully requests that the Commission and its Secretary accept this Notice regarding Laclede’s upcoming case filing.
