NOTICE OF CLOSING
FOR PRAIRIE HEIGHTS AND FREEMAN HILLS

COMES NOW Confluence Rivers Utility Operating Company, Inc., (“Confluence Rivers” or “Company”) and for its *Notice of Closing For Prairie Heights and Freeman Hills* respectfully states as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”):

1. On December 9, 2020, the Commission issued its *Order Approving Acquisition of Water and Sewer Assets and Granting Certificates of Convenience and Necessity* (“Order”) in this case. The *Order* requires Confluence Rivers to “...notify the Commission of closing within five days of closing on any of the assets in this case[.]”¹

2. In compliance with the Commission’s *Order*, Confluence Rivers hereby provides notice to the Commission that: on February 1, 2021, Confluence Rivers closed on the water utility assets of P.A.G. LLC d/b/a Prairie Heights Water Company (“Prairie Heights”); and on February 3, 2021, Confluence Rivers closed on the sewer utility assets of Freeman Hills Subdivision Association (“Freeman Hills”).

WHEREFORE, Confluence Rivers respectfully submits this *Notice of Closing For Prairie Heights and Freeman Hills* to the Commission.
