Mr. Taylor:

Thank you very much for spearheading this process and managing the various viewpoints. We think the draft as written is very sound with one key exception: S-REC origination. Specifically we believe all S-RECs should be generated in-state. As written, S-RECs could be purchased from states where S-RECs are not used for compliance (e.g. California) and are therefore worth very little. If S-RECs can be purchased from California to meet MO's RES then no significant solar project will ever be built in MO. We ask that the Commission modify the language to require all S-RECs be generated within MO.
