at the request of the Customer, the Company will refund to the Customer an amount equal to the excess charged for the water incorrectly metered, for a period equal to one-half of the time elapsed since the previous test, but not to exceed six months. No part of the minimum charge will be refunded.

- II. Slow Meters When a meter is found to have a negative average error i.e., is slow beyond the limit prescribed by the Commission and as set forth in Rule19 (L), in tests made at the request of the Customer, the Company may make a charge to the Customer for the water incorrectly metered for a period equal to one-half of the time elapsed since the previous test, but not to exceed six months. If a meter is found not to register for any period, the Company will estimate the charge for the water used by averaging the amounts registered over similar periods, preceding or subsequent thereto, or over corresponding periods in previous years.
- (O) In the event of a meter failing to register properly or when removed for testing or repairs, water bills will be rendered on an estimated basis as set out in Rule 19 (N) II.
- (P) When any meter has once been placed, any change in location directed by the Customer will be done by the Company, but at the expense of the Customer.

20. TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF BILLING AND PAYMENT

- (A) Private fire service charges, will be rendered annually, semi-annually, quarterly or monthly and payable in advance. Registration on a detector check meter will be included on the appropriate bill immediately following registration.
