MO PSC File No. TO-2023-0436 Responses to Staff Questions Received 07/12/2023 Pursuant to Investigation Order

- 1. Fully explain the company's broadband deployment progress, to date, in Missouri.
 - a. AUC response: Aristotle Unified Communications L.L.C. ("AUC") has identified and begun deployment at 14 locations. AUC is waiting on approval from 6 tribal nations, environmental clearance, and electrical service to bring another 17 sites fully live. However, AUC has also been preparing for the transfer of its CAF II Auction blocks in Missouri to a Missouri-based CAF II Auction recipient who was awarded over \$100 million for 60,000+ Missouri locations. AUC has signed a confidentiality agreement with this company and is not including its name in this public document; however, AUC will provide the company's name upon request. This transfer will take place pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, which allows transfers of USF obligations from one recipient to another. That company utilizes a different technology than AUC; therefore, radios will have to be redeployed before the network can be fully live. AUC has put off some additional deployments to prevent wasteful duplicative installations, but the Section 214 transfer process has dragged out much longer than originally anticipated. The current expected transfer date is 90-120 days from today. In addition, the new company has indicated that there are different and/or additional tower locations they prefer, meaning that some of the sites identified by AUC either will not be deployed or will be decommissioned. These changes will not cause a loss of broadband coverage to Missouri consumers. In fact, the technology deployed by the new company should increase both the speed and availability of broadband service to CAF locations.
- 2. Provide a copy of any documentation submitted to the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) regarding broadband deployment in Missouri.
 - a. AUC response: AUC provided data to USAC of specific address locations that AUC obtained through its address vendor. AUC's license with that vendor allows AUC to use that data specifically for submission into the USAC HUBB; however, under that license, AUC is not allowed to share that data with other entities for any purpose. AUC requested permission to share this data with Missouri PSC, but our vendor denied it.
- 3. Identify specific towers, location and date of installation of facilities used to deploy the company's fixed wireless broadband service in Missouri.
 - a. AUC response: Please see attached spreadsheet.
- 4. Explain why the company believes it is acceptable to claim broadband service has been deployed to a location when the company is unable to actually offer broadband service to that location. Cite any relevant FCC decisions supporting this belief.
 - a. AUC response: AUC is able to provide service from 14 vertical assets upon request. AUC is not advertising service because of the anticipated transfer of Auction blocks. The FCC has not defined specific advertising requirements.
- 5. Explain why the company is unable to currently provide broadband service to any Missouri consumers.

- a. AUC response: The premise of the question is inaccurate. AUC is currently able to provide service to some Missouri consumers but is not advertising for the reasons stated above. The new company will provide broadband services to Missouri consumers that are now or in the future would be within AUC's CAF II Auction coverage areas.
- 6. Explain the company's specific future plans for ensuring it meets subsequent broadband deployment milestones
 - a. AUC response: AUC is transferring 100% of subsequent broadband deployment milestone obligations to a Missouri-based CAF II Auction recipient pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934 which allows transfers of USF obligations from one recipient to another. Therefore, future deployment will be undertaken by that company, not AUC.
