## NOTICE OF COMPLAINT

## CERTIFIED MAIL

On May 22, 2000, Josh Davis (Complainant) filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission against Laclede Gas Company (Respondent). A copy of that complaint is enclosed. As provided in 4 CSR 240-2.070, Respondent shall have 30 days from the date of this notice to file an answer or to file notice that the complaint has been satisfied.

In the alternative, Respondent may file a written request that the complaint be referred to a neutral third-party mediator for voluntary mediation of the complaint. Upon receipt of a request for mediation, the 30-day time period shall be tolled while the Commission determines whether or not Complainant is also willing to submit to voluntary mediation. If Complainant agrees to mediation, the time period within which an answer is due will be suspended while the mediation process proceeds. Additional information regarding the mediation process is enclosed.

If Complainant declines the opportunity to seek mediation, Respondent will be notified in writing that the tolling has ceased and will also be notified of the date by which an answer or notice of satisfaction must be filed. That period will usually be the remainder of the original 30-day period.
