On January 4, 2002, the International Union of Operating Engineers Local No. 148, AFL-CIO, and the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers Local 1455, AFL-CIO, requested leave from the Commission to withdraw as parties to this case. The unions stated that they were not seeking any relief from the Commission and had no issues for consideration by the Commission.

An evidentiary hearing was held on January 8, 2002, at which all the parties were represented with the exception of the unions. At the hearing, each party present stated that it had no objection to the withdrawal of the unions. Therefore, the unions were granted leave to withdraw and were dismissed as parties to the case.

The parties agreed at the hearing to give closing statements in lieu of filing written briefs. Therefore, no briefing schedule will be set in this case. The Staff of the

Missouri Public Service Commission may, however, file suggestions supporting the stipulation and agreement filed on January 4, 2002. Any responses to suggestions of the Staff must be filed no later than January 23, 2002.
