### NOTICE REGARDING EX PARTE COMMUNICATION

On the afternoon of January 4, 2001, John Coffman, an attorney representing the Office of the Public Counsel dispatched an electronic communication or "e-mail" concerning the above-styled matter to each of the members of the Commission and to the presiding officer. This communication included a statement that it had been forwarded to all counsel of record in this case. The purpose of this communication was evidently to correct a perceived misstatement by the presiding officer made during the Commission's public session that morning.

The Commissioners and the presiding officer, in their role as adjudicators, are bound by the same rules as judicial officers concerning ex parte communications. The Commission considers the informal communication in question to be an ex parte contact and a copy has been provided to each party and placed in the official file. The Commission takes the additional step of issuing this notice in order to make it clear to the parties and their representatives that they should not communicate with the Commissioners regarding an active case except formally, by a pleading filed with the Secretary of the Commission and copied to every other party.

The parties must understand that casual communications such as the one which is the subject of this notice are not appropriate. The Commission conducts its business in public session at its Agenda Meetings, including deliberations and discussions of pending contested cases.

For these reasons, the Commission hereby advises the parties to this action to refrain from such casual and informal communications, whether electronic or by other means, with the members of the Commission or the presiding officer concerning a pending contested case. The parties may bring appropriate matters to the attention of the Commission by filing a pleading pursuant to the Commission's rules of practice and procedure.

On January 4, 2001, I received the attached document via electronic transmission from John Coffman. The document relates to a contested case currently under consideration by the Commission, Case No. ER-2001-299. The Commission is bound by the same *ex parte* rule as a court of law.

Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-4.020(4) it is improper for any person to attempt to sway the judgement of the Commission by undertaking, directly or indirectly, outside the hearing process, to bring pressure or influence to bear upon the Commission, or the Regulatory Law Judge assigned to the proceeding. Whenever such contact might occur, 4 CSR 240-4.020(a) states: as ex parte communications (either oral or written) may occur inadvertently, any member of the Commission or Regulatory Law Judge who received the communication shall immediately prepare a written report concerning the communication and submit it to the Chair and each member of the Commission. The report shall identify the person(s) who participated in the ex parte communication, the circumstances which resulted in the communication, the substance of the communication, and the relationship of the communication to a particular matter at issue before the Commission.

Therefore, out of an abundance of caution, I think it appropriate to submit this notice of ex parte contact pursuant to the standards set out in the rules cited above. This will ensure that any party to this case will have notice of the attached information and a full and fair opportunity to respond to the comments contained therein.


Clarification--Empire rate case--Case No. ER-01-299
