Description of MGU

- MGU serves the towns of Gallatin, Hamilton and Coffey and the surrounding rural areas
- CNG Holdings, Inc. formed MGU on January 1, 2005, from the Gallatin and Hamilton municipal systems, which were in receivership at the time of acquisition
- MGU has grown from 782 customers at acquisition to the current 863 customers

Gas Supply Plan


- Gas Supply Plan outlined in Status Report on Gas Purchases in Case No. GO-2005-0120 dated May 20, 2005
- Variation from the Plan as a result of the behavior of the natural gas market from June through September, 2005

Gas Supply Plan cont.

- Current Supply Options and Estimated Costs
 - Physical Market Purchases for Daily
 Consumption and Injection into Storage
 - Purchases "Locked In" based on NYMEX less a differential basis

Gas Supply Plan cont.

NYMEX vs ANR Index



Projected PGA/ACA

- Projected PGA based on Physical Market Purchases \$1.17/CCF
- Projected PGA based on NYMEX Purchases \$1.41/CCF
- ACA Adjustment (\$0.04/CCF)
- Estimated Commodity Costs for MGU Customers \$1.13/CCF

Low Income Programs

- LIHEAP and Weatherization Assistance
- Community Action Agency for Service Area 8 – Green Hills Community Action Agency
- Local Offices in Hamilton and Gallatin

Flexible Payment Options

- Level Monthly Payment Program
 - Currently 57 customers on Plan, 6.6%
- Payment Plans
 - Interest Free
 - Currently 4 customers on payment plans

- Gas Price Increase Letter to all customers dated September 22, 2005
- PGA/ACA letter anticipated October 28, 2005
- Gas Price Increase reminder letter inserted with the November bills
