In addition to relieving pressure on our aging, vulnerable grid and providing affordable, renewable energy to Missouri residents, the Grain Belt Express is good for Missouri municipalities because it will provide jobs, attract businesses with clean energy goals, add to the tax base of rural communities, and provide low-cost energy to cities.
