The accompanying tariff sheets issued by Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (Ameren Missouri or the Company), are being transmitted for filing as a revision of Schedule No. 2, Schedule of Rates for Gas Service:

These tariff sheets are being issued June 16, 2017 to become effective on and after July 1, 2017.

These revised sheets include changes to Company's Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) Clause as approved by the Commission. These revisions reflect adjustments to the Regular Purchased Gas Adjustment (RPGA) and Actual Cost Adjustment (ACA) factors.

The changes in the PGA factors applicable to the Company's service areas, excluding the Rolla area, will increase the firm sales customers' PGA factor from 51.00¢/Ccf to 56.00¢/Ccf. The interruptible sales customers' PGA factor will increase from 33.64¢/Ccf to 35.90¢/Ccf. The transportation PGA will remain unchanged at 0.00¢/Ccf.

The changes in the PGA factors applicable to the Company's Rolla system (Rolla, Salem, and Owensville) service area will increase the firm sales customers' PGA factor from 61.00¢/Ccf to 68.00¢/Ccf. The interruptible sales customers' PGA factor will increase from 34.89¢/Ccf to 37.15¢/Ccf. The transportation PGA factor will remain unchanged at 0.00¢/Ccf.

We are enclosing workpapers supporting this filing with the copy of this filing being provided to the Staff. The work papers have been designated "Highly Confidential" since they contain market specific information directly relating to the natural gas markets where Ameren Missouri must compete for its gas supplies. The Company requests that these papers be handled in a manner consistent with this designation.
