### **APPLICATION**

Comes now North Suburban Public Utility Company, Inc. ("North Suburban" or "Applicant"), by and through its counsel, and for its application pursuant to Section 393.190.2 RSMo 2000, 4 CSR 240-2.060, and 4 CSR 240-3.125 for permission to acquire more than ten percent (10%) of the capital stock of Lake Region Water & Sewer Company ("Lake Region"), respectfully states as follows:

- The legal name of Applicant is North Suburban Public Utility Company,
   Inc. Its principal office is located at 10777 Barkley Suite 210, Overland Park, Kansas
   66211.
- 2. North Suburban is a corporation duly incorporated under the laws of the State of Illinois. It is engaged, generally, in the business of owning and operating water and sewer public utility companies. North Suburban owns the capital stock of The Meadows Water Company and Ozark Shores Water Company, each of which are regulated by the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission"). Its ownership of the equity interests of both utilities was authorized by the Commission in its Case No. WM-2000-314.<sup>1</sup> North Suburban is not itself a regulated Missouri utility.
- 3. A certified copy of Applicant's Certificate of Authority to do business in the State of Missouri as a foreign corporation is marked **Appendix A**, attached hereto and

incorporated herein for all purposes. Because the Applicant is not a regulated Missouri utility, it has no pending or final judgments or decisions against it from any state or federal agency or court which involve its customer service or rates within the three (3) years immediately preceding the filing of this Application. Likewise, North Suburban has no overdue Commission annual reports or assessment fees.<sup>2</sup>

The Applicant wishes to obtain an order from the Commission which will allow it to acquire all of the outstanding capital stock of Lake Region, a Commission-regulated water and sewer corporation providing such services to customers on portions of Shawnee Bend at the Lake of the Ozarks in those areas certificated to it by the Commission.<sup>3</sup> Lake Region is a Missouri-chartered corporation. Such stock, in the form of 150,000 shares, is presently owned by Sally J. Stump, and RPS Properties (a limited

partnership owned and controlled by Robert P Schwermann, his wife and two children). Subject to the approval of the Commission, the shares will be transferred to North Suburban by Stump and RPS.

- 6. Applicant proposes to acquire all of these shares at the same cost as they were acquired by Stump and RPS. Because Stump and RPS (Robert P. Schwermann) are also principals of North Suburban, no formal statement of offer to purchase has been made by Applicant and no formal agreement has been entered into.
- 7. A certified copy of the resolution of the directors of Applicant authorizing the acquisition of the shares is attached hereto and marked as **Appendix B**.
- 8. Although not required by 4 CSR 240-3.125, Applicant has included a *pro forma* financial statement showing the effect on Applicant of the acquisition of the Lake Region shares described above. This document is attached hereto and marked as **Appendix C**.
- 9. The proposed acquisition of this stock by Applicant is not detrimental to the public interest. The Applicant and the principals of Applicant have extensive experience in the operation, management, maintenance and financing of water and sewer public utilities. No detrimental effect on the service provided by Lake Region is likely to occur from this transaction. There will be no change in the rate schedules or terms and conditions of service as are set forth in the tariff sheets of Lake Region which are on file with and approved by the Commission. The water and sewer operations of Lake Region will continue to be subject to the supervision and regulation of the Commission. As the *pro forma* financial statement shows, the Applicant has sufficient resources to be the share owner of these public utility companies.

10. The individuals who propose to transfer the shares involved in this application do not wish to hold the shares and they acquired them only temporarily with the intent to transfer the shares, at their cost, to Applicant. The individuals purchased the shares in order to close that transaction quickly since no regulatory approvals are required for individuals or partnerships to purchase such shares.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests an order from the Commission finding that the proposed transaction is not detrimental to the public interest and granting it permission to acquire all of the capital stock of Lake Region.


