NOTICE AND ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE TO AVOID DISMISSAL

On December 17, 1999, the Commission issued its Mediation Referral Order and Order Canceling Prehearing Conference. That order directed each party, individually, to contact the mediator to proceed with mediation (Ordered Paragraph 5) and to file monthly status reports during the course of the mediation (Ordered Paragraph 10). No status reports have been filed.

A complaint may be dismissed by the Commission for failure to comply with a Commission order. 4 CSR 240-2.070. Cases may be dismissed for lack of prosecution if no action has occurred in the case for ninety days. 4 CSR 240-2.116. A case may be dismissed for failure to appear for mediation. Id. A case may be dismissed for good cause after ten days notice to all parties. Id.

The parties have not complied with the Commission order and there has been no activity in this case for a period exceeding ninety days. Therefore, each party shall respond to this notice and show cause, if any, why this case shall not be dismissed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That each party shall file a response not later than June 16, 2000, informing the Commission of the status of this case and stating cause, if any, why this case shall not be dismissed for failure to comply with a Commission order and failure to prosecute.
 - 2. That this order shall be effective on June 6, 2000.
