#### APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY AND FOR COMPETITIVE CLASSIFICATION

COMES NOW ACN Communication Services, Inc., a Michigan corporation ("Applicant" or "ACN"), by its undersigned counsel, and hereby applies pursuant to sections 392.361, 392.420, and 392.430 RSMo 1994, 392.410, 392.450 RSMO Supp. 1998, and 4 CSR 240-2.060, for authority to provide facilities-based and resold basic local telecommunications service in portions of the State of Missouri in the exchanges of Southwestern Bell Telephone Company ("SWBT"), CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC ("CenturyTel") and Sprint Missouri, Inc. ("Sprint") and to classify said service and Applicant as competitive. Pursuant to Section 392.40 and 4 CSR 240-32.010(2) ACN also seeks a waiver of certain of the Commission's requirements for basic local exchange telecommunication's service offerings. In support of its Application, ACN states as follows:

1. ACN Communication Services, Inc. is a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Michigan on April 30, 1999, and is duly authorized to conduct business in Missouri. Pursuant to relevant provisions of 4 CSR 240-2.060, a Certificate of Authority to transact business as a foreign entity is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Appendix A. Applicant's principal place of business is 32991 Hamilton Court, Farmington Hills, Michigan 48334. Its telephone number is (248) 699-4000.

3. ACN's statutory representation in the State of Missouri is:

Missouri Local Application of ACN Communication Service, Inc.

4. By this Application, ACN Communication Services, Inc. requests certificate authority to provide competitive facilities-based and resold basic local exchange services to residential and business customers throughout all exchanges served by "SWBT," "CenturyTel" and "Sprint". The exchanges in which ACN seeks authority are listed in the approved tariffs of SWBT, CenturyTel and Sprint. ACN's proposed service areas will follow the respective exchange boundaries of the stated incumbent LECs and shall be no smaller than an exchange as required by Section 392.455(3) RSMo Supp. 1998. Applicant may seek authorization to provide service in exchanges served by other incumbent LECs in a subsequent proceeding.

ACN intends to provide service facilities-based local exchange service via the Unbundled Network Element Platform (UNE-P) offered by the ILECs. ACN plans to commence offering basic local service upon receiving Commission approval of its interconnection agreement(s) and related tariffs.

5. Pursuant to this Application, ACN seeks authority to offer and provide all forms of facilities-based and resold basic local telecommunications service to customers within Missouri as defined in 386.020(4) RSMo Supp. 1998. ACN is currently authorized to provide resold long distance telecommunications services within the state of Missouri and plans to offer bundled services consisting of local exchange and supplementary services along with long distance service.

ACN will, through interconnection with other carriers or resale of other carriers' services, provide access to 911 and enhanced 911 emergency services and provide directory assistance and operator assisted calling, dual party relay services, and other miscellaneous services currently provided by incumbent local exchange carriers.

ACN Communication Services, Inc. provides comprehensive customer service to its Customers. Complaints may be reported by the customer to ACN's customer service department. Customer service agents are available to answer customer service inquiries for new service, repair or with billing inquiries. Applicant's customer service representatives are prepared to respond to a broad range of service matters, including inquiries regarding: (1) the types of services offered by ACN and the rates associated with such services; (2) monthly billing statements; (3) problems or concerns pertaining to a customer's current service; and (4) general telecommunications matters.

Customer service is available during the hours of 8:00 AM to 9:00 PM EST, Monday through Friday and 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM EST, Saturday. On-call service is available, in the case of emergencies, twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week. Customers may contact the Company in writing at ACN's headquarters location at 32991 Hamilton Court, Farmington Hills, Michigan 48334, or by calling a toll-free customer service number to be provided on each invoice for service. ACN's toll-free customer service number is 888-226-9013.

6. Applicant possesses the technical and managerial expertise and experience necessary to provide the services it proposes as required by Section 392.455(1) RSMo Supp. 1998. ACN intends to provide service as both a facility-based and resale carrier and has assembled a management team with the expertise necessary to successfully operate as a competitive local exchange carrier. A listing of Applicant's principal management employees and their qualifications is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Appendix B. 7. ACN possesses the necessary financial qualifications to provide the services it proposes as required by Section 392.455(1) RSMo Supp. 1998. Current audited financial statements of ACN's parent company, American Communications Network, Inc., are available, and filed under confidential seal as noted in Appendix C. The information in Appendix C is submitted separately as an appendix to ACN's Motion for a Protective Order. This motion seeks confidential treatment of all information contained in Appendix C and is being filed pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.085, solely for the purpose of the Commission's *in camera* review.

8. Pursuant to this Application, ACN seeks classification of itself and its basic local telecommunications service offerings as competitive, with accompanying reduced regulation pursuant to Section 392.361 and 392.420 RSMo 1994 and 4 CSR 240-2.060(4)(F). The existing monopoly services of SWBT, CenturyTel and Sprint will make the local markets Applicant seeks to enter sufficiently competitive to make a lesser degree of regulation for ACN and its proposed services in the public interest, consistent with the legislative policies established by the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 and the recent revisions of Chapter 392 RSMo. This Commission already has approved several applications to provide resold and facilities-based local telecommunications services filed by new market entrants and has classified those new entrants and their services as competitive.

9. Applicant will offer its basic local telecommunications service as a separate and distinct service in accordance with Section 392.455(4) RSMO Supp.1998. ACN will provide equitable access for all customers in Missouri, without regard to their income or where they might reside, to affordable telecommunications services in Applicant's proposed service areas in accordance with Section 392.455(5) RSMo Supp. 1998.

10. Applicant is willing to comply with all applicable Commission rules and is willing to meet all relevant service standards including, but not limited to, quality service, billing, and tariff filing and maintenance. Consistent with the Commission's treatment of other certificated competitive local exchange telecommunications companies, Applicant requests that, at minimum, the following statutes and regulations for ACN Communication Services, Inc. and its basic and non-basic local exchange service offerings be waived at this time:

Applicant submits that the public interest will be served by Commission approval of this Application because Applicant's proposed service will create and enhance competition and expand customer service options, consistent with the legislative goals set forth in the Telecommunications Act of 1996 and Chapter 392 RSMo. Prompt approval of this Application also will expand the availability of innovative, high quality and reliable telecommunications services within the State of Missouri. Customers will benefit by having alternatives from which to choose and from general improvements in price, features and options that are generated by competitive market pressures.

12. The ACN Competitive Local Exchange Services tariff that contains the rules and regulations applicable to its Customers, a description of the services offered, and a list of rates associated with such services, is being filed simultaneously with this Application as Appendix D-1. The Company's Competitive Access Services tariff is filed with this Application as Appendix D-2. The tariffs have forty-five (45) day effective dates.

13. ACN has no pending or final judgments or decisions against it from any state or federal agency or court that involve customer rates or service.

14. ACN has no annual report or assessment fees that are overdue.

WHEREFORE, Applicant ACN Communication Services, Inc. respectfully requests that the Commission grant it a certificate of service authority to provide facilities-based and resold basic local telecommunications service as herein requested, classify Applicant and Applicant's proposed basic local services as competitive, and grant waivers of aforesaid statutes and regulations, as expeditiously as possible.


