NOTICE OF DISMISSAL

COMES NOW, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri (“Ameren Missouri” or “Company”) and for its Notice of Dismissal states as follows:

1. On June 29, 2015, Ameren Missouri initiated this proceeding by filing an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (application) requesting a certificate for its Montgomery solar project.

2. Ameren Missouri still intends to construct a solar facility at its Montgomery location; however, the timeframe for such construction has been changed and, consequently, the Company does not need a certificate at this time.

3. Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.116(1), Ameren Missouri notifies the Missouri Public Service Commission that it is voluntarily dismissing its application at this time.

WHEREFORE, Ameren Missouri voluntarily dismisses this application pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.116(1).
