

Amendment to
Interconnection Agreement
between
Nextel West Corp.
and
Southwestern Bell Telephone Company d/b/a AT&T Missouri

Pursuant to this Amendment (the "Amendment") Nextel West Corp., a Delaware Corporation, ("Nextel") and Southwestern Bell Telephone Company d/b/a AT&T Missouri¹ ("AT&T"), hereinafter referred to collectively as the "Parties" hereby agree to amend that certain Interconnection Agreement between the Parties dated August 25, 1998 and approved by the Missouri Public Service Commission, as amended ("the Agreement").

WHEREAS, Sprint and AT&T agree to amend the Agreement as set forth herein;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual provisions contained herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Sprint and AT&T hereby covenant and agree as follows:

1. The Parties agree to delete Section 18.2.1 in its entirety and replace it with the following:

18.2 Term and Termination

18.2.1 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this Agreement, AT&T and Carrier agree to interconnect pursuant to the terms defined in this Agreement for an initial period terminating November 21, 2011, and thereafter the Agreement shall continue in force and effect unless and until terminated as provided herein. Either Party may terminate this Agreement by providing written notice of termination to the other Party, such written notice to be provided at least sixty (60) days in advance of the date of termination; provided, however, that no such termination shall be effective prior to November 21, 2011. Until November 21, 2011, this Agreement may be terminated

¹ On December 30, 2001, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (a Missouri corporation) was merged with and into Southwestern Bell Texas, Inc. (a Texas corporation) and, pursuant to Texas law, was converted to Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., a Texas limited partnership. On June 29, 2007, Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., a Texas limited partnership, was merged with and into SWBT Inc., a Missouri corporation, with SWBT Inc. as the survivor entity. Simultaneous with the merger, SWBT Inc. changed its name to Southwestern Bell Telephone Company. Southwestern Bell Telephone Company is doing business in Missouri as "AT&T Missouri".

only via Sprint's request unless terminated pursuant to a default provision within this Agreement. By mutual agreement, AT&T and Carrier may amend this Agreement in writing to modify its terms.

2. All other provisions of this Agreement, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
3. Either or both of the Parties are authorized to submit this Amendment to the appropriate Commission for approval subject to section 252(e) of the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996.
4. This Amendment shall be filed with and is subject to approval by the Commission and shall be effective upon the date of the last signature of both Parties.




