

Mr. Davis:

I read with amazement that KCP&L has filed for a rate increase in excess of 17 percent. This is almost unbelievable. My wife and I are both retired and on a fixed income as well as being in our upper 70's.

I don't really understand why utility companies continually seek rate increases, where will it end. I have read with disbelief the amounts of money CEO's receive as one utility buys another out. Whatever happened to the companies using profits to upgrade plantings, lines, etc -- and not pay millions to outgoing CEO's?

I realize the increase cost of fuel has been used as a tool to increase rates to their customers. I don't think a reasonable rate increase is unfair, but a rate in excess of 17 per cent seems to be totally unreasonable. It appears that somewhere along the line greed has become an acceptable approach for gain.

If my wife and I, like thousands of KCP&L customers could receive a 17 plus percent increase in our fixed income, we would be in a better position to afford the requested rate increase.

We as consumer are continually becoming victims of all types of utility rate increases. I am very much opposed to the rate increase requested by KCP&L. I trust the Commission would deny that request.
