**SECOND NOTICE OF INTENDED CASE FILING**

COME NOW Liberty Utilities (Missouri Water) LLC (“Liberty Water”) and The Empire District Electric Company (“Empire”), both Liberty Utilities companies, and, pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-4.017, submit this Second Notice of Intended Case Filing with regard to their intended joint application for approval of the transfer of water assets, including all water service franchises and Certificates of Convenience and Necessity, from Empire to Liberty Water. In this regard, Liberty Water and Empire respectfully state as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission (the “Commission”):

1. Liberty Water and Empire filed their initial Notice of Intended Case Filing on June 4, 2019. Due to delays in the due diligence process, the joint application was not filed within 180 days of the date of the initial Notice of Intended Case Filing.

2. Liberty Water and Empire intend to file their joint application within the coming 60 days, and, as such, request that this file remain open.

WHEREFORE, Liberty Water and Empire submit to the Commission this Second Notice of Intended Case Filing. Liberty Water and Empire request such relief as is just and proper under the circumstances.
