**NUCOR STEEL SEDALIA, LLC AND
KCP&L GREATER MISSOURI OPERATIONS COMPANY’S
MOTION TO ALLOW WITNESS TO APPEAR BY TELEPHONE**

COMES NOW Nucor Steel Sedalia, LLC (“Nucor”) and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (“GMO”), and for their *Motion to Allow Witness to Appear By Telephone* (“Motion”) states as follows:

1. On July 12, 2019, GMO filed its *Application for a Special Electric Rate in Sedalia, Missouri* (“Application”), including the direct testimony of Kevin Van de Ven, Vice President and General Manager of Nucor (“Witness Van de Ven”).
2. Hearings in this matter are set to take place October 17-18, 2019.
3. During the scheduled hearing dates, Witness Van de Ven will be out of the country observing the testing of equipment for the steel mill Nucor is constructing in Sedalia.
4. To accommodate Witness Van de Ven’s travel, Nucor and GMO respectfully request that the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) allow Witness Van de Ven to testify via telephone during the hearing.
5. Additionally, to make the timing of Witness Van de Ven’s remote testimony easier, Nucor and GMO also request that the Commission allow him to be the first witness after the parties deliver their opening statements.
6. This request does not prejudice the other parties in any way.

7. Staff for the Commission (“Staff”), the Office of the Public Counsel (“OPC”), and Midwest Energy Consumers Group (“MECG”) have indicated that they have no objection to this Motion.

WHEREFORE, Nucor and GMO respectfully request the Commission issue an order permitting Witness Van de Ven to testify via telephone as the first witness at the upcoming evidentiary hearings.
