SUBJECT: Missouri Security Council

In the Governor's Executive Order 02-15, the Missouri Security Council was established (the "Council"). The Council shall serve as the mechanism for ensuring coordination of homeland security-related activities between executive agencies and local political subdivisions and effective development and implementation of homeland security policies.

In the Order 02-15, the "Chair of the Public Service Commission", Kelvin Simmons, was appointed as a member of the Council.

Wess Henderson, Director, Utility Operations Division, was selected to serve on the Deputies Council of the Missouri Security Council. The Deputies Council is the support group for the Security Council.


