REPORT AND ORDER

On May 4, 1973, South Jefferson County Utility Company (Applicant), 322 South Main Street, DeSoto, Missouri, filed With this Commission an application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate and maintain a water system and a sanitary sewage disposal system in a certain described area in Jefferson County, Missouri.

After due notice to all interested parties, the matter was heard on August 31, 1973, in the Commission's hearing room located on the tenth floor of the Jefferson State Office Building, Jefferson City, Missouri.

At the close of the hearing, the parties did not request oral argument or filing of briefs and waived the reading of the transcript.

Findings of Fact

The Missouri Public Service Commission, having considered all the competent and substantial evidence upon the whole record, makes the following findings of fact:

- water and sewer service as a public utility as defined by Section 386.020 RSMo 1969, and as a public utility would be subject to the Commission's jurisdiction pursuant to Chapters 386 and 393 RSMo 1969.

- 3. Service Area: Klondike Incorporated owns the Summer Set Subdivision Development which consists of about 720 acres of land. At the time of the hearing, there were 250 lots plotted but no building had taken place. The area is about two miles southwest of DeSoto, Missouri and approximately 35 miles south of St. Louis. There are no water or sewer services available in the area.
- 4. Accounts and Tariffs: The president of Applicant is aware that the company must keep its accounts in compliance with the Uniform System of Accounts, file proposed tariffs, rules and regulations with the Commission for approval and to keep continuing property records as required by the Commission.

Conclusions of Law

The Missouri Public Service Commission has arrived at the following conclusions:

The management of the Applicant has the financial and technical ability to serve the requested service area and it is economically feasible for the Applicant to serve the requested area as a public utility.

The Commission further concludes that public community venience and necessity will be served and promoted by the granting of the authority requested in the instant applications.

It is, therefore,

Company, 322 South Main Street, DeSoto, Missouri, be, and it is, hereby granted a certificate of convenience and necessity to operate and maintain a water system and a sewage disposal system in the described area in Jefferson County, Missouri, more issued described as follows:

herein authorized or within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this Report and Order, whichever shall occur first.

South Jefferson County Utility Company shall file subject to the approval of this Commission a schedule of rates, rules and regulations for water service to be furnished within the area herein described.

ORDERED: 3. That before instituting the service herein authorized or within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this Report and Order, whichever shall occur first, South Jefferson County Utility Company shall file subject to the approval of this Commission a schedule of rates, rules and regulations for sewer service to be furnished within the area herein described.

ORDERED: 4. That South Jefferson County Utility
Company, prior to instituting the service herein authorized,
shall file with the Commission operating permits in compliance
with the requirements of the Missouri Clean Water Commission
and Missouri Division of Health for all constructed facilities
in use.

ORDERED: 5. That nothing contained herein shall be construed as a finding by the Commission of the value for ratemaking purposes of the properties herein involved nor as an acquiescence in the value placed upon said properties by the Applicant.

ORDERED: 6. That this Report and Order shall become effective on the 3rd day of April, 1974, and the Secretary of the Commission shall serve a certified copy of same upon each interested party.

- 4. Applicant has employed L. J. Antoine and Associates, Inc., Consulting Engineers to make an evaluation and an economic feasibility study, which includes, but is not limited to:

 - c. Plans for financing.

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d. Cost of installation over 2 years and estimated entire cost.

This lot has located on it a drilled well and the lot and well has a value of \$20,000.00. Map showing area sought to be served by applicant, feasibility stucy of proposed system and any required consents or franchises will be filed as exhibits prior to hearing of this application by the Commission.

6. The method of financing the systems will be set forth in full in the leanibility study to be filed prior to the hearing of this application.

WHEREFORE, applicant prays that the Commission enter its order granting is certificate of public convenience and necessity to applicant to furnish water rervice and to provide a sanitary sewage disposal in the area described in Exhibit 2, and for such other and further orders as the Commission finds meet and proper.


