**NOTIFICATION THAT KCPL HAS EXERCISED  
AUTHORITY GRANTED BY THE COMMISSION**

1. Pursuant to 4 C.S.R. § 240-2.080 and Section II.A(2)(g) of the Stipulation and Agreement approved by the Missouri Public Service Commission ("MPSC") in the above-captioned proceeding, Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCPL") hereby respectfully provides notice that it exercised the authority granted by the Commission in its order approving the Stipulation and Agreement, effective October 1, 2006.

2. The Stipulation and Agreement approved by the MPSC in this proceeding directed KCPL to file notice within 10 days after KCPL exercises the authority granted in the order, *i.e.*, to transfer functional control of certain of its transmission assets to Southwest Power Pool Inc. ("SPP").

3. As of October 1, 2006, KCPL has received all substantive regulatory approvals for the transfer of functional control of certain KCPL transmission assets to SPP. The Kansas Corporation Commission, by order dated September 19, 2006 in Docket No. 06-WSEE-203-MIS, granted approval for the transfer of functional control of KCPL transmission assets to SPP. The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC"), by letter order dated September 27, 2006 in Docket No. ER06-1318-000, accepted the *Agreement for the Provision of Transmission Service to Missouri Bundled Retail Load* ("Service Agreement") between SPP and KCPL. FERC established an effective date for the Service Agreement of October 1, 2006.

4. FERC's conditioned its acceptance upon SPP re-filing the Service Agreement with the FERC to reflect non-substantive format changes in the page headers and footers that do not add to, delete, or alter the language of the Service Agreement in any respect. FERC acceptance of the Service Agreement was a condition of final MPSC approval of the Stipulation and Agreement, a condition that now has been substantively fulfilled.

5. KCPL has received the necessary regulatory approvals and has exercised the authority granted by the MPSC in this proceeding, establishing an Effective Date of October 1, 2006 under the Stipulation and Agreement.
