ORDER ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

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At the prehearing conference held on May 3, 2005, and in continuing discussions thereafter, the parties agreed upon dates for local public hearings and for an evidentiary hearing. The Commission will adopt these dates, and provide a date for the filing of the list of issues, list of witnesses, and order of cross-examination.

The local public hearings will allow affected customers the opportunity to comment. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, representatives of Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCPL), representatives of the Office of the Public Counsel, and the other parties to the case will be available for a half-hour before the beginning of the local public hearing in order to provide information about the issues to be considered by the Commission in this proceeding.

The Information Office of the Commission will be directed to provide notice to the members of the General Assembly who represent the counties in KCPL's service territory, and to the newspapers, as listed in the newspaper directory of the current **Official Manual of the State of Missouri**, that serve the counties in KCPL's service territory. The Data Center of the Commission shall serve a copy of this order upon the county commission of

each county in the KCPL's service territory. KCPL will be ordered to publish notice in those same newspapers.

The following conditions shall apply:

(A) The parties shall agree upon and the Staff shall file a list of the issues to be heard, the witnesses to appear on each day of the hearing and the order in which they shall be called, and the order of cross-examination for each witness. Any issue not contained in this list of issues will be viewed as uncontested and not requiring resolution by the Commission.

(B) Each party shall file a statement of its position on each disputed issue. Such statement shall be simple and concise, and may not contain argument about why the party believes its position to be the correct one.

(C) The Commission's general policy provides for the filing of the transcript within ten working days after the hearing. If any party seeks to expedite the filing of the transcript, such request shall be tendered in writing to the Presiding Judge at least five days prior to the date of the hearing.

(D) All pleadings, briefs and amendments shall be filed in accordance with 4 CSR 240-2.080. Briefs shall follow the same list of issues as filed in the case and shall set forth and cite the proper portions of the record concerning the remaining unresolved issues that are to be decided by the Commission.

(E) All parties are required to bring an adequate number of copies of exhibits that they intend to offer into evidence at the hearing. The party offering an exhibit should bring, in addition to a copy for the court reporter, copies for the five Commissioners, the Presiding Judge, and all counsel.

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IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the following procedural schedule is established:

The first local public hearing shall be held on May 24, 2005, at the Jackson County Courthouse, Legislative Assembly Area, 415 East 12th Street, 2nd Floor, Kansas City, Missouri. This local public hearing will commence at 12:00 noon and will continue until all persons present have had an opportunity to testify, but in no case later than 2:00 p.m. An informal presentation and question and answer session will be conducted before the hearing, beginning at 11:30 a.m.

The second local public hearing shall be held on May 24, 2005, at the County of Platte Executive Offices, 415 Third St., 2nd Floor, Administrative Building, Platte City, Missouri. This local public hearing will commence at 6:30 p.m. and will continue until all persons present have had an opportunity to testify, but in no case later than 8:30 p.m. An informal presentation and question and answer session will be conducted before the hearing, beginning at 6:00 p.m.

The evidentiary hearing shall be held in Room 310 of the Commission's office in the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri.

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Each of these three hearings will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards of the Americans with Disabilities Act. 2. That the Data Center and Information Office of the Commission shall serve a copy of this order and provide notice as described in this order.

3. That Kansas City Power & Light Company shall cause to be published a notice of the hearings in the newspapers, as listed in the newspaper directory of the current **Official Manual of the State of Missouri**, which serve the counties in its service territory.

4. That this order shall become effective on May 6, 2005.
