**APPLICATION FOR CANCELLATION OF CERTIFICATE OF
SERVICE AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE INTRASTATE INTEREXCHANGE AND
NONSWITCHED LOCAL EXCHANGE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

COMES NOW AT&T Corp., pursuant to Section 392.410.5 RSMo and the rules of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”), and hereby requests that the Commission cancel its certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange and nonswitched local exchange telecommunications services in the state of Missouri. In support thereof, AT&T Corp. states as follows:

1. AT&T Corp. is a New York corporation with its principal office at One AT&T Way, Bedminster, New Jersey, 07921. AT&T Corp. is authorized to do business in Missouri¹ and its fictitious name is duly registered with the Missouri Secretary of State.² AT&T Corp. is duly authorized to provide telecommunications service within the State of Missouri.

2. AT&T Corp. may be contacted at the electronic mail address, facsimile and telephone numbers of its attorneys, as set out under the signature block of this Application. All correspondence, pleadings, orders, decisions, and communications regarding this proceeding should be sent to:

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3. AT&T Corp. has no pending action or final unsatisfied judgments or decisions against it from any state or federal agency or court which involve Missouri retail customer service or rates, which action, judgment or decision has occurred within three (3) years of the date of this Application.

4. AT&T Corp. does not have any annual report or assessment fees that are overdue in Missouri.

5. On September 25, 2008, the Commission granted AT&T Corp. a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange and nonswitched local exchange telecommunications services in Case No. TA-2009-0045.

6. Until this fall, AT&T Corp. provided Missouri business customers, pursuant to Commission-approved tariffs, certain advanced telecommunications services known as PremierSERV™ Asynchronous Transfer Mode Service, PremierSERV™ Frame Relay Service and Frame Relay Digital Service (“ATM/Frame Relay Services”). The assets which enable the provision of these services to customers were recently transferred to Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri (“AT&T Missouri”), which now provides these services to Missouri customers.³ Effective as of October 31, 2011, AT&T Missouri adopted each of AT&T Corp.’s tariffs.⁴

7. The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate of service authority pursuant to Section 392.410.5 RSMo, which states in pertinent part that “[a]ny certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the [C]ommission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.” However, the Commission need not hold a hearing if, following proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests a hearing.⁵

8. The services once offered pursuant to AT&T Corp.’s certificate of service authority and its tariffs are now offered and provided exclusively by AT&T Missouri. AT&T Corp. has no customers subscribing to any of these services. In these circumstances, canceling AT&T Corp.’s certificate is appropriate.

WHEREFORE, AT&T Corp. respectfully requests that the Commission cancel its certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange and nonswitched local exchange telecommunications services in the state of Missouri.






