Come now the Small Telephone Company Group, which companies are set out in Attachment A, (hereinafter referred to as "Applicants") and in support of their Application to Intervene in the above-captioned matter state that:

- 1. Applicants currently provide telecommunications services to members of the public located in those areas certificated to them by the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission"). As is relevant to this case, Applicants provide "basic local telecommunications services" within the exchanges as defined by their respective tariffs which are on file with and approved by the Commission. Applicants are "telecommunications companies" and "public utilities" as those terms are defined by § 386.020, RSMo Supp. 1998, and are, therefore, subject to the jurisdiction, regulation and control of the Commission as provided by law. Applicants also are rural telephone companies and incumbent local exchange carriers as defined by the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the "Act").

- 3. On February 10, 2000, NewPath Holdings, Inc. ("NewPath") filed an Application requesting a certificate of service authority to provide switched and dedicated resold and facilities-based basic local exchange telecommunications service and facilities-based local exchange service in the State of Missouri. Specifically, NewPath wishes to provide switched and dedicated basic local exchange telecommunications service on a facilities and resold basis throughout the State of Missouri.
