**SOUTHWESTERN BELL TELEPHONE, L.P., D/B/A AT&T MISSOURI'S
APPLICATION AND MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT**

COMES NOW AT&T Missouri,¹ and files this verified application and motion for expedited treatment, pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.060, 4 CSR 240-2.080(16), and 47 CFR 52.15(g)(3)(iv), and respectfully requests that the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") issue an Order that reviews and reverses the decision of the North American Numbering Plan Administrator, NeuStar, Inc. ("NANPA") to withhold certain numbering resources from AT&T Missouri.

The numbering resources which are the subject of this Application consist of a single thousands-block having an 816 NPA, and any NXX assignment such that the accompanying XXXX assignment is within the range of 2XXX through 7XXX (i.e., 816-NXX-2XXX through 816-NXX-7XXX). These numbering resources are necessary to service the needs of Lee's Summit Hospital at a new facility in Lee's Summit, Missouri, in a manner consistent with the hospital's recent order for the installation of 1000 Direct Inward Dial ("DID") numbers. In support of this application, AT&T Missouri states as follows:

1. AT&T Missouri is a Texas limited partnership,² duly authorized to conduct business in Missouri,³ with its principal Missouri office at One AT&T Center, Room 3520, St. Louis, Missouri, 63101. AT&T Missouri is authorized to do business in Missouri and its fictitious name is duly registered with the Missouri Secretary of State.⁴ AT&T Missouri is a “local exchange telecommunications company” and a “public utility,” and is duly authorized to provide “telecommunications service” within the State of Missouri as each of those phrases is defined in Section 386.020, RSMo. 2000.

3. Lee’s Summit Hospital, a telecommunications service customer of AT&T Missouri, is presently located at 530 NW Murray Road in Lee’s Summit, Missouri. Lee’s Summit Hospital is opening a new location at 2100 SE Blue Parkway. It is anticipated that the hospital’s facilities presently located at 530 NW Murray Road will be moved to 2100 SE Parkway, by means of a phased-in move which is currently targeted for completion in early 2008.

4. The numbering resources needed are intended to service the needs of various health care providers (e.g., physicians, nurses, other staff), rooms for accommodating patients, staff and meetings/conferences and other telecommunications-related purposes. Specifically, Lee's Summit Hospital has requested numbering resources consisting of 1000 consecutively-numbered telephone numbers having an 816 NPA, and any NXX assignment such that the accompanying XXXX assignment is within the range of 2XXX through 7XXX (i.e., 816-NXX-2XXX through 816-NXX-7XXX) in connection with its pending order for 1000 DID trunks. The XXXX thousand-blocks beginning with 0, 1, 8 and 9 are unacceptable because they would conflict with the hospital's internal dialing plan and its access to its outside trunks.

5. AT&T Missouri has researched the available blocks in the Lee's Summit rate center which serves Lee's Summit Hospital. AT&T Missouri has no available thousands-blocks available for use that meet Lee's Summit Hospital's needs. In order to best meet these needs, AT&T Missouri requests that the Commission grant it the numbering resources requested herein.

6. A copy of the correspondence from Mr. Gregg Eggleston of Hospital Corporation of America, acting on behalf of Lee's Summit Hospital, received by AT&T Missouri on January 24 and February 24, 2007, respectively, is attached hereto and is marked as Exhibit B. As noted therein, the numbering resources requested are needed "immediately to establish [a] numbering plan for [the] new hospital." AT&T Missouri believes it is important that this Application be granted so that Lee's Summit Hospital can establish a 4-digit dialing plan that would allow a consistent and uniform dialing configuration.

7. On February 28, 2007, AT&T Missouri submitted a Thousands-Block Application Form, Part 1A, for assignment of the numbering resources from which AT&T Missouri could meet Lee's Summit Hospital's request. A copy of the Application is attached hereto and is marked as Exhibit C. AT&T Missouri completed the application in accordance with the Industry Numbering Committee's Thousands-Block Pooling Assignment Guidelines and filled out the necessary Months to Exhaust and Utilization Certification Worksheet which is attached hereto and is marked as Exhibit D.

8. AT&T Missouri submitted the request for the block because AT&T Missouri does not have numbering resources available to service Lee's Summit Hospital's needs. AT&T Missouri is unable to use numbers from any other switch in the Lee's Summit rate center to satisfy Lee's Summit Hospital's request.

9. On or about February 28, 2007, NANPA denied the request on the grounds that AT&T Missouri had not met the utilization criteria. That decision is attached hereto and is marked as Exhibit E.

10. Under existing procedures, NANPA has asserted that it is required to accept or reject an application for resources based solely on FCC criteria. However, the FCC's March 31, 2000, Order in its Number Resource Optimization docket states that a carrier may challenge a resource denial before the appropriate state regulatory commission and a state commission may choose to reaffirm or overturn NANPA's decision to withhold numbering resources.⁵ Thus, the Commission has the authority to "affirm or overturn the NANPA's decision to withhold numbering resources from the carrier based on its determination of compliance with the reporting and numbering

resource application requirements herein.”⁶ Moreover, the FCC determined that states may overturn NANPA’s decision to withhold numbering resources from the carrier where there is a verifiable need for the carrier to satisfy a specific customer request:

We also agree with WinStar that a carrier should be able to get additional numbering resources when there is a verifiable need due to the carrier’s inability to satisfy a specific customer request. We therefore clarify that states may also grant relief if a carrier demonstrates that it has received a customer request for numbering resources in a given rate center that it cannot meet with its current inventory.⁷

11. The FCC further explained in its March 31, 2000, Order that a “[c]arrier may demonstrate such a need by providing the state with documentation of the customer request and current proof of the utilization in the rate center” and that states “may grant requests for customers seeking contiguous blocks of numbers.”⁸ Moreover, although the FCC declined to establish a specific timeframe for states to act on these requests, the FCC indicated “in most instances, 10 business days from receipt of request that the state determines to be sufficiently detailed and complete will be sufficient time to review and act upon safety valve requests.”⁹

12. AT&T Missouri seeks the Commission's direction to overturn NANPA's decision to withhold numbering resources. This Commission has overturned NANPA's decision to withhold numbering resources in several cases.¹⁰

13. AT&T Missouri does not have any pending or final unsatisfied judgments or decisions against it from any state or federal agency or court which involve customer service or rates, which action, judgment, or decision has occurred within three (3) years of the date of this Application.

14. AT&T Missouri does not have any annual report or assessment fees that are overdue in Missouri.

15. As noted in Lee's Summit Hospital's letter (Exhibit B), Lee's Summit Hospital confirms that numbering resources requested herein are needed "immediately to establish [a] numbering plan for [the] new hospital." The hospital's telecommunications system is currently en route but the hospital will be unable to utilize it as intended absent the additional numbering resources requested by this Application. The requested numbers are needed as soon as possible, so that Lee's Summit Hospital can begin the tasks of assigning numbers to each location, determining features and limitations based

on user, programming the PBX and installing and testing all telecommunications-related facilities and equipment.

16. Consequently, AT&T Missouri seeks expedited treatment and requests that the Commission act on this request within ten (10) business days as envisioned by the FCC, or as soon thereafter as is practicable for the Commission. To the extent that the Commission can issue its order as soon as possible, AT&T Missouri can thereafter expeditiously file a new request with NANPA for the release of the needed numbering resources to AT&T Missouri. AT&T Missouri filed this request for expedited treatment as soon as it could have. Specifically, AT&T Missouri filed this pleading after NANPA rejected its request for numbering resources and AT&T Missouri determined that it was not feasible to implement a technological alternative.

WHEREFORE, AT&T Missouri respectfully requests that the Commission overturn NANPA's previous determination in this matter within ten business days as envisioned by the FCC, and instruct NANPA to release the numbering resources necessary to meet the needs of Lee's Summit Hospital.

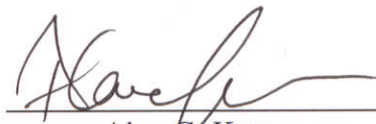

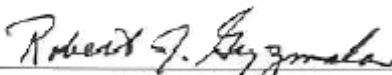

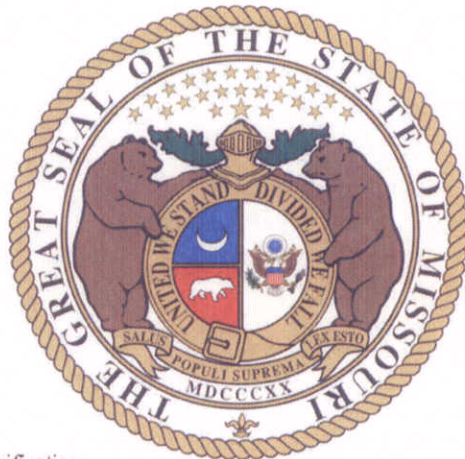

Instructions for filling out each Section of the Part 1A form:

Section 1.1 Contact information requires that Service Providers supply under “Block Applicant” the company name, company headquarters address, a contact within the company, an address where the contact person may be reached, in addition to the correct phone, fax, and e-mail address. The Pooling Administrator section also requires the Service Provider to fill in the Pooling Administrator’s name, address, phone, fax and e-mail.

Section 1.2 Service Providers who need a thousands-block assignment or for an Location Routing Number (LRN) are required to fill in this section. If needed for an LRN, a CO Code Application needs to also be submitted to the PA. The Service Provider should supply the Numbering Plan Area (NPA); the Local Access Transport Area (LATA), which is a three-digit number that can be found in the Telcordia™ LERG™ Routing Guide. The Operating Company Number (OCN) assigned to the service provider and the OCN its parent company. An OCN is a four-character alphanumeric assigned by Telcordia™ Routing Administration (TRA). In addition, the number of thousands-blocks requested should be supplied. The Switch Identification as well as the city or wire center name, rate center, rate center sub zone, homing tandem and CLLI™ tandem of the facilities based provider^{viii}. Explanations of these terms may be found in the footnotes.

Section 1.3 The date the Service Provider completes the application should be entered in this section, as well as the Effective Date of the requested thousands-block.

Section 1.4 Service Providers should indicate their type, e.g., local exchange carrier, competitive local exchange carrier, interexchange carrier, CMRS. They also indicate the primary type of business in which the numbering resource is to be used. Service Providers also may indicate their preference for a particular thousands-block, e.g., 321-9XXX, or indicate any thousands-blocks that may be undesirable, e.g., 321-6XXX.

Section 1.5 Service Providers indicate the type of request. Initial requests are for first applications for thousands-blocks in a rate center, growth for additional thousands-blocks in a rate center in which the applicant already has numbering resources, and provide the required evidence as ordered by the FCC.
