MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT

COMES NOW Missouri Gas Energy, a division of Southern Union Company (MGE or Applicant), and, in accordance with Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(16), moves the Commission for expedited treatment of MGE's tariff, as filed on January 8, 2008:


1. On January 8, 2008, the Commission issued its Order Approving Adjusted ISRS Rates, Rejecting Submitted Tariff, and Authorizing MGE to File Tariff in Compliance. In that Order, the Commission rejected the tariff sheet filed by MGE on October 17, 2007 (YG-2008-0240), and authorized MGE to file a tariff to impose an ISRS as specified in the Order.
2. Concurrently, with the filing of this Motion, MGE filed a tariff sheet in order to comply with the Commission Order (7th Revised Sheet No. 10) (provided herewith as **Appendix A**). This tariff sheet carried a proposed effective date of February 7, 2008 (30 days), and was assigned tracking number YG-2008-0419.
3. MGE seeks the Commission's order allowing the proposed tariff sheet to go into effect on January 23, 2008.
4. The ISRS process is authorized by Sections 393.1009, 393.1012 and 393.1015, RSMo, and Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.265. Its goal is to provide eligible gas corporations with the ability to recover, on a timely basis, certain infrastructure replacement costs outside of a formal rate case filing via the ISRS. The Commission has authorized such an ISRS in this case

and there are no further procedures to be completed in this case. Granting this Motion will afford MGE the timely rate relief which the Commission has found to be justified. As such, Commission action as requested will be consistent with the public interest as established by the General Assembly and Commission order.

5. The subject tariff sheet and this Motion have been filed as soon as possible after the issuance of the Commission's Order Approving Adjusted ISRS Rates, Rejecting Submitted Tariff, and Authorizing MGE to File Tariff in Compliance.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, MGE respectfully requests the Commission to grant MGE's Motion for Expedited Treatment and approve MGE's proposed tariff sheet (YG-2008-0419) effective January 23, 2008.

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
