1. MAWC intends to close the transaction that is the subject of the Commission's

Order Granting Certificate of Convenience and Necessity on May 23, 2017.

2. Concurrently, with the filing of this Motion, MAWC has filed water and sewer

tariff sheets consistent with the Commission's Order Granting Certificate of Convenience and Necessity. These tariff sheets carry proposed effective dates of June 18, 2017 (30 days), and have been assigned tracking numbers YW-2017-0244 and YS-2017-0245.

3. MAWC hereby seeks the Commission's order allowing the proposed tariff sheets to go into effect on less than thirty days notice.

4. A grant of this motion will further the public interest. The subject transaction will be closed on May 23, 2017. As of that date, MAWC will own and operate the subject systems. The subject tariff sheets are intended to clarify the rates, rules and regulations that will apply to the subject customers on a going-forward basis. Addressing these tariff sheets in an expedited manner will eliminate or reduce any gap that might exist in regard to these subjects.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, MAWC respectfully requests the Commission

grant this Motion for Expedited Treatment and approve MAWC's proposed tariff sheets (YW-

2017-0244 and YS-2017-0245) to be effective on May 23, 2017, or as soon thereafter as the

Commission has the opportunity to address this matter.
